
SERMON NOTE: Honour The LORD


Reasons We need to Tithe

How to Tithe?





1. God needs it

• I have no need of a bull from your stall or of goats from your pens. For every beast of the forest is Mine, and the cattle on a thousand hills. I know every bird in the mountains, and the wild beasts of the field are Mine. "If I were hungry, I would not tell you, for the world is Mine, and all that is in it. Psalms 50:9-11

3. Biblical example : Abraham

 Then Melchizedek king of Salem brought out bread and wine. He was the priest of God Most High. And he blessed Abram, saying, "Blessed be Abram of God Most High, Creator of heaven and earth; And blessed be God Most High, Who has delivered your enemies into your hand." And Abram gave him a tenth of everything. Gen 14:18-20

Biblical example : Jacob

"If God will be with me, and keep me in this way that I am going, and give me bread to eat and clothing to put on, so that I come back to my father's house in peace, then the Lord shall be my God. And this stone which I have set as a pillar shall be God's house, and of all that You give me I will surely give a tenth to You."
Gen 28:20-22

4. Law

- And all the tithe of everything from the land, whether grain from the soil or fruit from the trees, belongs to
- · The entire tithe of the herd and flock, every tenth animal that passes under the shepherd's rod, will be
- tithe as the LORD's offering. Num 18:26

5. Act of worship

 But who am I, and who are my people, that we should be able to give as generously as this? Everything comes from You, and we have given You only what comes from Your abundance that we have provided for building You a temple for Your Holy Name it comes

Act of worship

- The people rejoiced at the willing response of their leaders, for they have given freely and wholeheartedly to the Lord; and King David also rejoiced greatly, 2Chron 29:9
- Honor (حدד) the LORD with your wealth and the firstfruits of all your crops. Prov 3:9

How much to give?

- The Law requires the Israelites to pay a tenth
- We are under grace do we still follow the Law?
- · A tenth of our income?
- · A tenth of our profit?
- · A tenth of our allowances?
- · Net or gross?

- New Testament did not mention the amount one should tithe but our attitude in tithing
- 2Cor 9:7 Each man shall give what he decide in his heart to give
- 2Cor 9:6 but remember whoever sows...
- Luke 6:38..with the measure you use it will be measured to you

Sows sparingly will reap sparingly, sows generously will reap generously.

When we honor the LORD with our giving.....

- Prov 3:10 then will your barns be filled to overflowing, your vats will brim over with new
- Luke 6:37 Give and it will be given you a good
- 2 Cor 9:8 God is able to make all grace abound to you, so that in all things at all times having all you need you will abound in every good
- 2Cor 9:11 You will be made rich in every way so that you can be generous on every occasion and through us your generosity will result in thanksgiving
- Malachi 3:10 "Bring the whole tithe into the storehouse, that there may be food in My house. Test Me in this," says the Lord Almighty, "see if I will not throw open for you the floodgates of heaven and pour out so much blessing that you will not have

Finally

- We give generously, cheerfully and willingly not to so that God will bless us but we give because we have been greatly blessed!!!!
- Rom 8:32 He who did not spare His own Son but gave Him up for us all, how will He not also, along with Him, graciously give us all
