

Oppositions – Ezra 4


The work of rebuilding was stopped

## Prophet Haggai


 "This is what the LORD of Heaven's Armies says: The people are saying, 'The time has not yet come to rebuild the house of the LORD'" (1:2)

• "Then the LORD sent this message through the prophet Haggai: 'Why are you living in paneled houses while my house lies in ruins?" (1:3-4)






Zerubbabel Ezra (457- Nehemiah (537-516) 444) (444-430) 80 years after 1st Return





- Who is Ezra?
  - Son of priesthood lineage Ezra 7
  - His grandfather Hilkiah helped in the reform during King Josiah
  - 7:6, "a teacher well versed in the Law of Moses..."
  - ".. the hand of the LORD God was on him."



- His mission to teach the Law of God
- to restore the temple worship
- he was however immediately confronted with a big problem

- Detestable practices of the neighbouring people
- many Israelites were involved – leaders, priests, Levites..






- It began with intermarriage

- Joshua 23:13, " ... until you perish from this good land, which the LORD your God has given you."


1 King 11:6, "Solomon did evil.."

built altars for idols in high places




- Ezra was appalled and terribly grieved.
- He tore his clothes, pulled his hairs, sat there until the evening sacrifice
- He prayed

- In his prayer (Ezra 9:6-15)
  - he expressed he was ashamed & disgraced
  - he recognised the sins that resulted in Exile
  - he acknowledged God's grace of a remnant God's kindness of a new life to rebuild
  - He lamented over the repeat offence




- Ezra 10:1
- "While Ezra was praying and confessing, weeping and throwing himself down before the house of God, a large crowd of Israelites men, women and children gathered around him. They too wept bitterly."

- They were touched by his actions and confession.
- it marked the beginning of healing
- Later a national confession in Nehemiah 10








- James 1:14-15

- or someone more than God



### **Love is Paramount!**




Remember, Repent! Return to Love!
