
## God favors the humble

resentment.




## Tremble at His word

## King Josiah's remorse



#### 2 Kings 22: 3-11

During a repair mission at the Temple in Jerusalem, the High Priest recovers the lost Book of the Law. He reads it to King Josiah, who responds to learning God's commands about idolatry by tearing his robes in repentance.



• Tell the king of Judah, who sent you to inquire of the LORD, 'This is what the LORD, the God of Israel, says concerning the words you heard: Because your <u>heart was responsive</u> and you humbled yourself before the LORD when you heard what I have spoken against this place and its people....and because you tore your robes and wept in my presence, I also have heard you, declares the LORD.



### Daniel 9:1-3

• In the first year of Darius son of Xerxes (a Mede by descent), who was made ruler over the Babylonian kingdom— <sup>2</sup> in the first year of his reign, I, Daniel, understood from the Scriptures, according to the word of the LORD given to Jeremiah the prophet, that the desolation of Jerusalem would last seventy years. <sup>3</sup> So I turned to the Lord God and pleaded with him in prayer and petition, in fasting, and in sackcloth and ashes.





- Responded to Jeremiah's prophecy
- Remorse sackcloth and ashes
- Prayer of confession and pleading for mercy/deliverance

Holy reverence lead to powerful prayer









  - of pride and confidence in self.








### Contrite heart


