
Bible Ref: Psalm 61:1-4 NIV

- נָחָה *Nachah* - to guide, to bring, to transport, to lead forth (pillar of cloud leading the Israelites in the wilderness)

IN THE ROCK

- Is the refuge
- Is the strong tower against the enemies
- Is the shelter of His wings

THE ROCK

- Ascribe greatness to our God, He is the Rock, His work is perfect and all His ways are just. A faithful God who does no wrong, upright and just is He. Deut. 32:4
