


Mark 7:24-30 (Matt 15:21-28)

24 Jesus left that place and went to the vicinity of Tyre. He entered a house and did not want anyone to know it; yet he could not keep his presence secret.

25 In fact, as soon as she heard about him, a woman whose little daughter was possessed by an impure spirit came and fell at his feet.

26 The woman was a Greek, born in Syrian Phoenicia. She begged Jesus to drive the demon out of her daughter.


27 "First let the children eat all they want," he told her, "for it is not right to take the children's bread and toss it to the dogs."

29 Then he told her, "For such a reply, you may go; the demon has left your daughter." (Matt 15:28, "Woman you have great faith! Your request is granted.")

30 She went home and found her child lying on the bed, and the demon gone.






Jesus' Galilean Ministry






As soon as she heard – The Pursuit

- She knew Jesus was her only hope




She cried out to Jesus – The Petition





Healings at a distance

Healings at a distance

- the sick or demon-possessed couldn't come.
- They didn't or unable to ask Jesus for their own healing.
- Instead, a boss (Centurion), a father or a mother petitioned to Jesus on behalf of their loved one.
- Jesus only spoke to these people who were interceding. Yet the sick or demon-possessed were healed!
