


No one like test or examination. But examination push us to be better or know more or even to excel.

Only after examination, when one gone through and success, he will be able to performs certain task and able serve the society.






Sir William Smith, persisted and served with dignity formed Boys Brigade and became the first and oldest Uniform Group.
